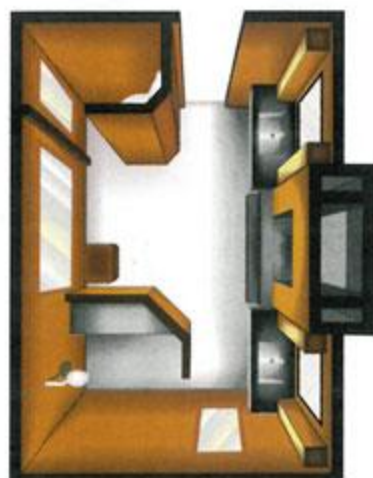

Sea-Inspired Spa

DURING THIS FRANKLIN LAKES, New Jersey, family's home renovation, the owners decided an addition was necessary to fully carve out the creative master bathroom they envisioned. Even before building began, they brought on Peter Salerno, CMKBD, of Peter Salerno Inc. to prepare a plan.

As that plan played out, the space became a one-of-a-kind place to get pampered. Salerno created an oversized corner shower with a large seat, multiple showerheads, and pebble floor. The half-wall provides privacy while maintaining an open feeling. The concrete top on the shower wall features fiber optic lighting that bathes the outside of the shower in a soft, even glow in the evening. Also adorned with fiber optics, the two-sided fireplace features up-lighting mounted in its concrete mantle. Another style connection between the shower and fireplace, a Lake Blue limestone was used on the fireplace fascia as well as the angled shower surrounds.

Other notable features include his-and-her vanities flanking the fireplace, statuary marble tile floor with mosaic marble border, and concrete countertops made to look like the ocean. In fact, they feature recycled glass, stone, black sand, embedded extinct ammonite fossils from Madagascar, and a wave-patterned edge—all details that make this sea-inspired spa stunning. *Learn more about this designer at www.petersalerno.com.*
